DESCRIPTION

This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of early childhood education settings who work within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standard. They support the implementation of an approved learning framework, and support children's wellbeing, learning and development. Depending on the setting, educators may work under direct supervision or autonomously.

- The program is targeted at domestic students with or without any prior experience or you could be in an on-the-job situation (currently employed or actively seeking employment in child care industry i.e. a regulated education and care service).

RTO ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be 18 years or older. SITS requires students to complete a customised Language, Literacy & Numeracy (LLN) assessment. LLN assessment is conducted to identify any support individual learners need prior to their enrolment or commencement.

WORK PLACEMENT

Students must participate in a minimum of 120 hours of work placement and students need to find a registered and approved education and care service setting to gain practical skills.
